The Fitchburg Art Museum (FAM) education department is responsible for connecting the community with the museum resources, and designing learning experiences that foster creativity, inquiry, and community involvement through art. We work with a variety of audiences to engage them with collection objects, exhibitions, and working artists in the region. FAM educators work closely with multiple community partners to design programs that facilitate equitable access to the arts and sustain the cultural vitality of our region.

Internship Focus

Interns will assist the staff with the planning and implementation of educational programs, gallery interpretation, and community partnerships. Tasks may include supporting front-facing programs such as group tours, after-school, family programs, summer camp and artist workshops. Behind-the-scenes tasks may include administrative, documentation and data collection, research, marketing and the development of interactive learning spaces.

- Available to work occasional evenings and weekends for special programs
